

New Hope Center FAQ

What hours is New Hope Center open?

Mondays- 10am-1pm

Tuesdays- 3pm-6pm

Wednesdays 10am-1pm

Saturdays- 9am-noon

What services does New Hope Center provide?

We provide food and clothing only for anyone living in HEB. We will gladly serve anyone outside of HEB once and direct them to their local food pantry. Anything needed outside of food and clothing we refer out for.

How often can I come to New Hope Center?

You can come once a month.

What do I need to bring with me to receive assistance?

Please bring a photo ID and proof of residency, we do not ask for income level or any financial documents.

How do I qualify for services?

No qualification needed, just proof of ID and residency in HEB. If you do not live in HEB we will serve you one time and then refer you to your local food pantry.

How long does the process take?

Generally the process can take anywhere from 45 minutes to an hour and a half. It depends on how busy we are and if you need to shop for clothes. If you just need food the process should only take 30 minutes. We recommend at least showing up 45 minutes before we close so you have time to get everything you need.

Where can I drop off donation items?

Please drop off during open hours only (refer to question #1 for our hours). Simply drive around to the back of New Hope Center, look for signs and a double door that says New Hope Donation Station. Come in through the back of New Hope and a volunteer dressed in a blue 6 Stones shirt will be glad to help you.

What donation items do you accept?

We accept smoke free gently used clothing and shoes for all ages and sizes (no stains, tears, or rips), brand new socks/underwear, & gently used toys/books. We also accept light household items such as: pots/pans, dishes, towels, blankets, sheets, etc. We do not accept furniture, appliances, TVs or used socks/underwear.

Do you pick up clothing donation items?

No, we are not able to pick up clothing donation items unless it is from a department store or warehouse wanting to donate items. We generally only pick up large food donation items or items needed to support our other programs.

What food donation items do you accept?

We accept all food as long as it is not expired. Here is a list of items we are always in need of: pasta sauce, cereal, canned meat, jelly, canned fruit, hamburger helper, pancake mix, syrup, baby food, and baby wipes.

Where do you get your food?

We get our donations from local businesses, churches, schools, and cities who do food drives for us. We also make weekly runs to the following local locations for food: Kroger, Whole Foods, Papa Johns, Pizza Hut, QT, Cheesecake Factory, & Chick-Fil-A.
