1) [New Hope Center:](#)

Due to the current climate 6 Stones is postponing the interior opening of the New Hope Center. We will continue to serve our neighbors through drive-thru service. We will continue to temperature check volunteers prior to entry, wear masks, practice social distancing, and ensure the health and safety of our neighbors, volunteers, and staff.
